What should I already know?

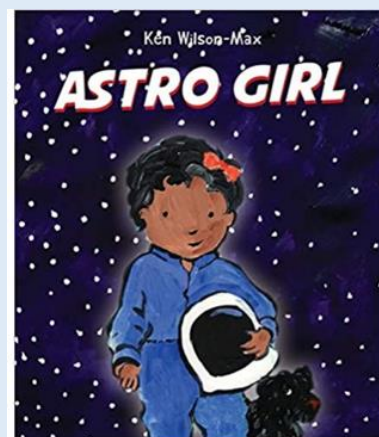
- People that are older than me, were born before me.

What should I know by the end of this theme?

- Mary Peters was born in Halewood in 1939.
- In 1970 she won Gold in shot put and pentathlon events at the Commonwealth Games in Edinburgh.
- In the 1972 Summer Olympics in Munich, Peters competing for Great Britain and Northern Ireland won the gold medal in the women's pentathlon, setting a new World Record.
- Now lives in Belfast and has a statue of her in the athletics track named after her.
- Katarina Johnson-Thompson was born in Halewood in
- She is an English track and field athlete specialising in the heptathlon and pentathlon.
- She won gold medal for heptathlon at the 2019 World Championships in country of Qatar.
- She holds the British record for pentathlon and heptathlon
- The Olympic Games take place every 4 years
- The next Summer Olympics take place in 2020 in Tokyo, Japan
