

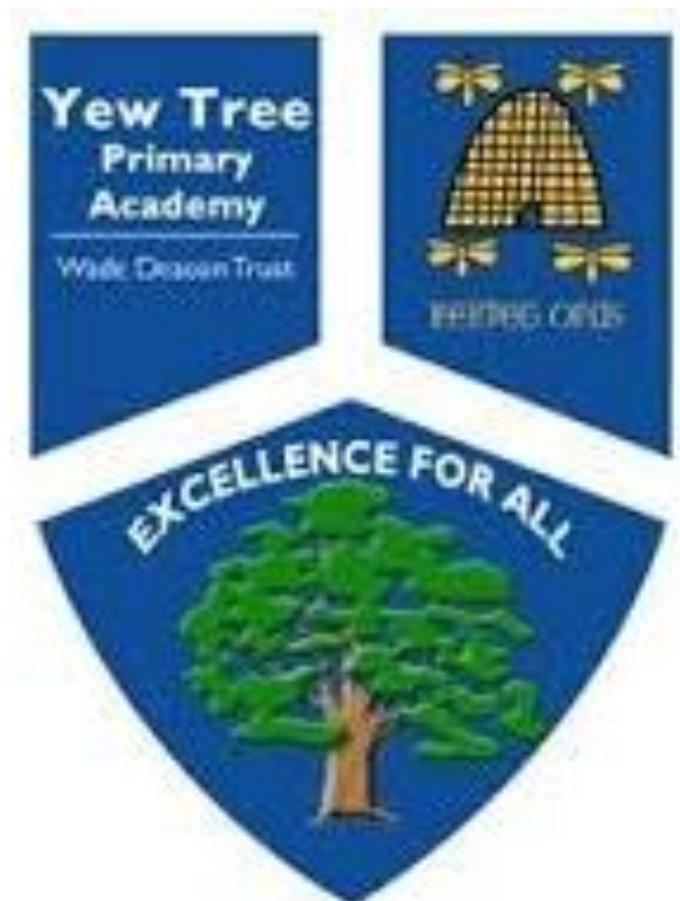

Reading

Letters from the Lighthouse and How does a Lighthouse Work through a mixture of independent and shared reading, children will be answering questions that will require them to interrogate the text in order to retrieve, infer and analyse the language choices made. They will participate in discussion about both books that are read to them and those they can read for themselves, taking turns and listening to what others say.

Geography

UK Countries and Cities

The children will use atlases, maps and globes to locate UK regions, countries and cities. They will identify famous landmarks and use the eight point compass to describe locations. They will know that seas are areas of salt water which separate oceans from land. They will study the River Mersey from its source to the Irish Sea. The children will learn about the components of the water cycle.

Pupils will improve their defending and attacking play, developing further knowledge of the principles and tactics of each.

Gymnastics

Pupils create longer sequences individually, with a partner and a small group. They learn a wider range of actions such as inverted movements to include cartwheels and handstands.

In this chapter, pupils explore decimals. To begin this chapter, they learn to read and write decimal numbers. This is followed by comparing decimal numbers to find which is greater and smaller. Pupils then add and subtract decimals before turning decimals into fractions. The chapter ends with pupils rounding decimals to the nearest whole number and decimal position.
